Motion to approve the Meeting Agenda, with a correction, was made by Commissioner Treadway, **seconded by Commissioner Looper, and passed collectively.**

Commissioner Manning acknowledged the presence of representatives from Echo Stage, Gateway, Woodridge, Langdon Park, DPW, DDOT, and the offices of Mayor Bowser and Councilmember Kenyan McDuffie

Reading of Minutes of Previous Month was waived. Report was not available

Reading of Treasury Report was waived. Report was not available

Fifth District Crime Report- PSA 503 Sergeant Herring. There is a 4% reduction in crime in comparison with the previous month's statistics. New crime suppression beats have been established in the 1800-1900 Blocks of Providence Street and Capital Avenue and near the hotels and gas stations. A midnight shift scooter tactical unit has been added.

DC Department of Transportation representative Rodney Foxworth presented ANC 5C updates and took questions from the Commission and community.

Alternative Solution Medical Marijuana Cultivation Center Representative Bob Simmons requested support from the ANC to expand his facility to a neighboring warehouse and to increase the number of marijuana plants to 1,000. Chairperson Manning determined via questions, answers, and community input that the community affected by the proposed expansion had not been notified of the expansion. Therefore, the ANC took no action on this matter.

Mayor Muriel Bowser's representative Tommie Jones requested support from the community for the Mayor to protect the Homeless during the impending cold weather. He also sought to garner volunteers for the Mayor's snow removal team; specifically, those who will clear snow from the public space in front of the homes of the elderly and disabled.

Curb Cut for Driveway – Myrtle Ave, LLC requested a curb cut in order to install a driveway and parking pad at 2610 Myrtle Avenue, NE. A motion to approve this request, with a Myrtle Avenue, NE map drawing correction was made by Commissioner Brevard, seconded by Commissioner Manning, and passed collectively.

Commissioner Looper announced due to his new employment duties, he would have to relinquish his position as Treasurer for the 5C ANC.

Community Announcements – The floor was open to all who wanted to speak regarding their community activities and events.

Motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Manning seconded by Commissioner Brevard, and passed collectively.
