Minutes for Wednesday December 16, 2015

Motion to approve the Meeting Agenda, with a correction, was made by Commissioner Manning, seconded by Commissioner Deleon, and passed collectively.

Reading of Minutes of Previous Month's Meeting- Commissioner Deleon. The reading was waived and a motion was made by Commissioner Deleon to accept the report; seconded by Commissioner Smith; and approved collectively by the Commission.

Reading of Treasury Report- Commissioner Looper stated there is \$33,166.57 in the Checking Account; \$10,008.12 in the Savings Account; and no expenditures. A Motion was made by Commissioner Manning that each Commissioner shall be reimbursed for the future purchase of individual ANC business cards and that the current Treasury Report be accepted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Deleon and passed collectively by the Commission.

Commissioner Looper added he will vacate his position as Treasurer after the submission of the Quarterly Treasury Report, which is due by December 21, 2015.

Fifth District Crime Report- PSA 503 Sergeant Herring reported there is an 8% reduction in crime in PSA 503 in comparison with the previous year's statistics. Burglaries are up in the area of Michigan Avenue and Bunkerhill Road, NE. Tactical units have been added to address the problem. Traffic enforcement has increased in the area of Eastern Avenue and Bunkerhill Road.

Commissioner Manning acknowledged the presence of representatives from the Offices of the Mayor and Councilmember McDuffie; Langdon, Woodridge, and Gateway Civic Associations; Friends of Woodridge Library; and the St. Francis Desales Parish.

Office of Kenyan McDuffie Representative Laisha Daugherty's announcements included the Councilmember's opposition to the issuance of a Liquor License to MMA by TMI (2066 Rhode Island Avenue, NE).

Mayor Muriel Bowser's Representative Tommie Jones publicized the Mayor's January 1, 2016 2nd Annual 5K event.

ANC 5C02 (Commissioner Deleon) Introduced a Resolution for a five (5) year ABRA moratorium on new nightclubs and liquor licenses within a 1,500 feet radius of 2135 Queens Chapel Road, NE. Motion was introduced by Commissioner Deleon; seconded by Commissioner Manning; and passed collectively by the Commission in support of the resolution.

ANC 5C03 (Commissioner Looper) presented a zoning variance request to reduce a two-family unit to a single-family unit at 3101 35th Street, N.E. Motion was introduced by Commissioner Looper; seconded by Commissioner Treadway; and passed collectively by the Commission in support of the variance.

ANC 5C04 (Commissioner Manning) introduced a protest of an ABRA application for a new beer garden and rock climbing establishment at 1240 Mt. Olivet Road, NE. The new establishment would include live entertainment, an outdoor summer garden, and alcohol sales. The protest concerned the lack of parking, noise, and trash. Motion was introduced by Commissioner Manning; seconded by Commissioner Looper; and passed with four Commissioners supporting the protest and two Commissioners abstaining.

Community Announcements – The floor was open to all who wanted to speak regarding their community activities and events.

Motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Looper; seconded by Commissioner Smith; and passed collectively. Next Meeting is set for January 20, 2016
