Motion to approve the Meeting Agenda, was made by Commissioner Treadway, seconded by Commissioner Smith, and passed collectively.

Reading of Minutes of Previous Month’s Meeting- The reading was waived and a motion was made by Commissioner Brevard to accept the report; seconded by Commissioner Treadway; and approved collectively by the Commission.

Reading of Treasury Report- The reading was waived due to the absence of the Treasurer. Commissioner Treadway entered a motion to participate in the ANC Security Fund Program. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Manning and passed collectively by the Commission.

Swearing-in of Officers 2016- Lead by Mr. Gottlieb Simon, D.C. Government Office of the ANC. Commissioner Manning made a motion that Mr. Simon accept her list of nominees for office; seconded by Commissioner James; and passed collectively by the Commission. Those sworn-in at that time were Jacque Manning-Chairperson, Nolan Treadway- Vice Chairperson, and Gail Brevard-Secretary.

Fifth District Crime Report- PSA 503 Sergeant Herring reported since December 2015, violent crimes (homicides, sex abuse, armed robberies, and assaults with deadly weapons) are up. Property crimes, such as thefts from autos, are down. Traffic enforcement has increased near 22nd and Randolph Streets, NE and in the area 31st Street, in the Gateway Community. A special evening crime beat has been established in Ivy City and near Saratoga Avenue, NE

Commissioner Manning acknowledged the presence of representatives from the Office of the Mayor; MPDC Citizens Advisory Committee; Friends of Rhode Island Avenue; and Woodridge South.

Mayor Muriel Bowser's Representative Tommie Jones publicized the Mayor's readiness for the upcoming blizzard and her one-year report on the state of D.C.

ANC 5C07 (Commissioner Treadway) presented a Resolution requesting the Government of the District of Columbia fund the estimated annual operating and startup costs for the proposed MetroExtra bus service along the length of Rhode Island Avenue. After questions were addressed, Commissioner Treadway entered a motion for the approval of the Resolution, with corrections. Commissioner Manning seconded the motion and the Resolution was approved collectively by the Commission.

Reimbursement for Business Cards-Commissioner Treadway entered a motion that Commissioner Brevard be reimbursed for the expenses she incurred in the purchase of ANC 5C01 business cards. The cost was less than \$50.00. Commissioner Looper seconded the motion and the motion was passed collectively by the Commission.

Community Announcements – The floor was open to all who wanted to speak regarding their community activities and events.

Commissioner Looper was sworn-in as Treasurer for the 2016 5C Commission by Mr. Simon at 8:11 pm.

Motion to adjourn was made by Commissioner Treadway; seconded by Commissioner Manning; and passed collectively. Next Meeting is set for February 17, 2016
